Thank you very much for your inquiry regarding the computer installation. I am taking the liberty of enclosing a copy of an abstract concerning the recent operations of the center, as this may interest you.

Most of the energies of the center have been devoted to EEG analyses. At the present time, I am exploring the possibility of expanding the program into Bibliography work and into the classification of psychiatric patients, using various rating scales as source material. I am particularly interested in various pattern profile programs, especially those that might follow the techniques of McQuitty and Oberall.

These programs are being developed in conjunction with the computer center of Washington University. We are actively interested in expanding our programming staff and would be pleased to consider the appointment of someone who has a present interest in the goals of our program.
