Dear Joe,

As I promised you at our luncheon last week, I am pleased to send you this draft copy of a manual of digital computer methods for EEG analysis which my associate, Dr. Don Shapiro, and I have written during the past few months. I was very pleased to hear that you were undertaking a study of neuro-physiological measures. You will find no program in this volume for evoked potentials. In part, this reflects the emphasis which I have placed on the resting EEG patterns. However, the equipment lends itself to programming such techniques.

Rather than go through the additional changes for modifying the 1401 program, Don has arranged for some time on the IBM 360 using the 1401 simulator. We will undertake the TTR analyses at the end of this week.

I hope the volume is helpful.
