Dear Mrs. Allyn:

I believe we have sufficient information to make definitive arrangements for our forthcoming trip to participate in the International Congress of Psychology.

We will be accompanied by an additional member of our party, Mr. Andrew Green. He is fifteen years old and will share the accommodations of my son. For this reason, wherever necessary we would like to request two rooms - one twin bedded and one double bedded, if possible. I would appreciate your sending me another set of forms for the necessary visas and I will return these promptly.

We would like to take advantage of the 21 day fare and would like to leave New York for Paris on Pan American 114 on August 3, at 8:30 pm.

Please arrange for accommodations at the hotel at the Paris Airport for the night of August 4.

Reservations should also be requested for the flight Paris to Moscow on SU 050 for August 5, leaving at 12:30 pm, arriving in Moscow at 6:15 pm.

We will need accommodations in the best available class in Moscow from Friday evening August 5, until August 10.

We would like to leave Moscow on Wednesday, August 10 for Leningrad and will need accommodations on the Red Arrow Special leaving Moscow at 11:55 pm on Wednesday, August 10.

Please arrange for accommodations in the delux class in Leningrad for the evenings of August 11, 12 and 13.

We will next need reservations for a flight from Leningrad to Moscow. I do not think that we would like to take the train in both directions and from your letter, it is probable that air reservations can be made to connect with the Moscow-Budapest flight SU 033, which your letter indicates will fly on August 14. Since August 14 is a Sunday, I would be grateful if you would check carefully that this flight does indeed go at the time indicated.

We will need overnight accommodations in Budapest.

We would like accommodations on the flight Budapest to Vienna (MA 389) and Vienna to Istanbul (PA-2) for August 15.

The connections from Istanbul to Athens and Athens to Rome should be listed on our tickets but left as open accommodations.

Finally, we will need reservations from Rome to New York on August 24.

Enclosed are the visa applications for the Soviet Union for three members of our party. We already hold valid U. S. Passports, although my own will have to be renewed and I will accomplish this directly.

Since the biggest difficulties that we anticipate will be the transatlantic portion and the reservations in the Soviet Union, I would be grateful if you would expedite these accommodation requests.

In rereading your letter, it may be possible to leave Moscow directly for Istanbul without a stopover if we did not take the Red Arrow Special from Leningrad to Moscow. Perhaps there is an early morning flight connection from Leningrad to Moscow and Moscow to Istanbul so that we will not have an overnight stay on route. If this is possible, I would appreciate your letting me know.
