Enclosed is a copy of the anti-anxiety drug protocol relating to doxepin, and a carbon of the letter which I recently sent to Dean Clyde. You will note that I sent the latest CDT report and some earlier memos regarding item analyses to Dean.

Dr. Cremata called me today to state that the parenteral form of doxepin was not yet available and that the protocol will be filed with the FDA excepting section three on page three and including the first line of page 4. He believes that the parenteral form will be available soon and would like a revised EEG protocol from us. If you would like to carry out this portion of the study, would you make up a suggested protocol.
