Dear Miss Peereboom:

Enclosed are the galley proofs for the Symposium VI "Anticholinergic Drugs and Brain Function in Animals and Man" which are to be published as part of the Proceedings of the Vth International Congress of the CINP. I have reviewed the sequency of papers and would recommend that they be published in the order in which they are sent to you, notably, the introductory statement; followed by the papers by Bradley, Longo, Domino, Itil, Fink and Itil, Carlton, Bures, Herz, White and Rudolph, Cuculic, Bost and Himwich, Votava *et al.*, Votjehovsky *et al.* and Vitek *et al.*

I have reread the introductory few lines and am taking the liberty of enclosing a better summary of the full symposium. If it is possible to publish these few paragraphs, I believe they will enhance the symposium immeasurably.
