I have received the enclosed application from Dr. Lantin, an English physician who has had considerable psychiatric experience. Dr. Lantin is interested in joining the staff of the Institute or the St. Louis State Hospital as a staff psychiatrist.

He holds the D.P.M. from the London conjoint board, received from the Maudsley Hospital in 1948. At that time, the pre-examination requirements were less than recently. In summarizing his training, I find that he has had two years of residency training followed by five years of supervised out-patient therapy, averaging 5 - 7-1/2 hours a week.

His references are excellent. He was interviewed by Dr. Margerison who has given us a picture of a physician interested in developing a career in psychiatry.

I believe that he has the qualifications for the position of Senior Research Scientist (Medical) and/or that of Physician III. I would appreciate the presentation of his credentials to the Personnel Division for his name to be placed on either register.
