SUBJECT: Service Functions, Ward 15A and OPD

On an annual basis, we admit 400 patients for observation and detoxification. Of these, about 100 receive further treatment, on methadone, and continue in our aftercare program.

The detoxification procedure follows the established techniques of reducing dosages of methadone, requiring 7-14 days observations. Aftercare consists of meetings with rehabilitation counselor, social worker, and education specialists, as well as individual and group psychotherapy.

Admission is restricted to males, 18 years of age and older, and residents of New York City.

The average a patient stays for detoxification is 9 days; for methadone 60 days; and cyclazocine 30 days. Outpatient stays varies for 1 month to 6 years to date.

During 1971, we regularly cared for 100-110 patients in the OPD, seen on the average 2-4 times each week. A sample month run-down (March, 1971) is attached. In addition, we respond to consults regarding drug abuse on 12B, 13A-B, and all of Metropolitan Hospital.

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The professional staff treating these patients includes those on - 067, at an annual rate of \$199,081. (List attached).

In addition, the research staff, supported by MH 18172, 19176, 13358 and 47-072 spend varying amounts of time in the studies on 15A, including heroin-antagonist research, cannabis, and EEG. On an annual basis, these sums are:
