

The studies of cycloserine, with or without Dilantin undertaken at the University of Missouri were completed in the winter of 1965. Unfortunately, I moved from Missouri in May of 1966 and have not had an opportunity to summarize the information. I have contacted one of my associates and asked that the data be summarized.

The study was discontinued in the winter of 1965 and each of the investigators were notified. The unused supplies of cycloserine were discarded in Missouri and are no longer available.
