Dear Miss Slotky:

I am writing with regard to the report "Long-Acting Depot Phenothiazine Treatment of Psychosis." My associates in St. Louis have reviewed the paper and I am enclosing pages which they feel warrant correction.

The page numbers referred to are your page numbers, marked in the upper right hand corner. On page 4, the last line of paragraph 1 should read "4 to 96 weeks." In paragraph 2, three lines from the bottom delete "(Table 2)." The last sentence should be changed by deleting "discomfort and secondary" and replacing by "extrapyramidal."

On page 5, the paragraphs require a few changes and these are marked on the attached page 5.

The principal changes are in the results and I have taken the liberty of retyping pages 6 and 7. Following your editing, please use these to substitute for all of 6 and most of page 7 up to the portion marked secondary effects.

On page 8, we would suggest that paragraphs be deleted from the section starting "10 patients in group 1" and "9 patients in group 2".

Similarly, the section on page 9 "there was no weight loss" is logically a continuation of the previous paragraph.

In the summary, in paragraph 2, the third line should be changed to read "dischargeable, and seven did not improve. The" (the word secondary should be deleted).
