Dear Dr. Guerrero:

I have recently become interested in the report written by yourself, Feinstein & Gottlieb, in the EEG Journal, 1956. I note that you indicate that several subjects, "especially in the post-shock group, became disturbed after the injection of benadryl." We have checked the literature and have not been able to find this report.

I am particularly interested in the relationship between the disturbed behavior and the pretreatment EEG. Were the subjects who had delta activity more disturbed than those who did not? Also, was there any relation to dosage and the appearance of the EEG changes?

If your manuscript is available, I would appreciate the opportunity to read it and will gladly return it within a few days.
