Dear Gloria:

I have an opportunity to discuss the tri-hospital study early next month. If you have the stencil of the paper "Sociopsychological Aspects of Psychiatric Treatment in Three Voluntary Hospitals", would you be able to run off 50 copies of each of the tables, 1-5, and send them to me by November 5th?

So far we have not heard whether this paper has been accepted for publication and I have only one copy. Did we make a stencil of a draft approximately 7/13/62? If we did, would you send me about 15 copies? If not, see if you have any other stencil of this paper and if it is not too early a draft, could you run off 15 copies?

Separately I have sent Don Klein the paper for Psychopharmacologia which has been accepted for publication. There are some suggested editorial changes and it would be nice to send to the editors a new copy with whatever corrections he makes. You might save one typing by getting his approval for making a stencil, and sending the two copies the editor wishes from the stencilled version. If so, could you please send me 10 copies?

If there is some reason not to make a stencil immediately, perhaps you could do this in your leisure time over the next few weeks. Thank you very much for sending the additional copies of the book to Dr. Bouthilet. Did you have any luck with a tracer on the first package?
