Dear Ray:

Your letter of August 6, was received while I was on vacation, which explains the delay in answering you.

You are quite correct that Figure 1 might be interpreted as you suggest. However, my associates and I have indicated that this progress report reflects some problems in behavioral control and EEG sampling. We believe we are correcting these in the present study.

We are now completing the data analysis on two volunteers testing different behavioral control devices. Within the next few days we will launch the definitive study, and we trust that we have provided adequate controls for some of the questions raised in our progress report of April 1965.

With regard to your visit on Monday, October 4, I regret that this is a difficult time for us. Dr. Itil is scheduled to return from Europe on October 2, and I am scheduled to be in Connecticut on October 4 and 5. I cannot check with Dr. Ulett as he is on vacation. I would suggest that October 12, 13 or 14, are preferable dates for us and both Dr. Itil and I would have more time available on October 13. I trust that this will be agreeable with you.
