Dear Mrs. London,

I have re-written the article on opiate dependence, under the title, *Treatment and Prevention of Opiate Dependence with Narcotic Antagonists*, and sent it to my typist, for delivery to you early next week. It is sent on the understanding that it will be included in the Spring, 1972 issue.

As I discussed, it may be useful for your editors to consider the invitation to some of the scientists interested in the problems of drug abuse to your Board, and I suggested that you consider Dr. Alfred M. Freedman, Chairman, Department of Psychiatry of this College, and/or Prof. Stanley Yolles, Chairman, Department of Psychiatry, State University of New York at Stony Brook. Both these men have a long history of interest in the problems of drug abuse and have maintained a balanced and theoretically sound position on most of the contemporary issues.

The other article, *Biology of Cannabis*, will require re-writing even more extensive than that for the antagonists. There is so much research activity at present, that to be timely the article should be prepared at the latest time possible to meet your deadlines. Depending on the time of the year, you should re-extend your invitation about 10-20 days before the final deadline. It should not be too difficult to meet your request.

Good luck in your endeavor.
