I have read the information which you made available to me regarding the Marlboro State Hospital with a great deal of interest. I have discussed this research opportunity with two of my former associates at the Missouri Institute of Psychiatry. Dr. Nafi Kiremitci has indicated an interest in this position and may write to you separately.

I met Dr. Kiremitci when he was an assistant in psychiatry at the New York State Psychiatric Institute in 1961. He returned to Turkey to complete his military duty and was appointed to the Missouri Institute of Psychiatry in July 1965.

He has been actively involved in the research programs there, especially in the studies of new compounds as they effect behavior of the severe mentally ill. He has an experience with populations similar to those at the New Jersey State Hospital.

He has recently completed the requirements for licensure in two states and is scheduled for the examinations of the American Board of Psychiatry at their next meeting.
