The grant is "EEG and Human Psychopharmacology" (MH-13358) and is a continuation of studies begun at Hillside Hospital (1954-1962) (MH 927, 2715, 2092), and at the Missouri Institute of Psychiatry (1962-1966) (MH 08517, 11380, 11381) and in New York (1966-) (MH-13003). The program is focussed on quantitative EEG aspects of psychopharmacology, and in this regard is relatively unique in the ECDEU program. Our focus on addicts and normal volunteers are two other unusual features.

I have asked Dr. Levine to visit us this summer, to provide an opportunity to discuss the directions we are now taking. I would be pleased if you would join him, and use the occasion to become acquainted. I trust we can meet before the fall rush of meetings.
