Dear Dr. Clark,

Enclosed is a draft copy of a suggested protocol for the evaluation of AHR-1900. This protocol has been approved by my staff and has been submitted to the appropriate committees for approval. I am also enclosing a completed FD 1572, and supplementary copies of the rating scales and laboratory data form to be used.

The completed study should result in a clinical report, analyses of the behavioral changes by the Biometric Laboratory of NIMH, analyses of the laboratory data by Biodata, Inc., and a summary of the EEG patterns.

While there are some administrative hurdles to be overcome before the study can be undertaken, I believe it can begin within the next 6 weeks. Before submitting a request for drug supplies or for grant support, it would be most helpful if you could arrange a visit to these laboratories on one of your trips North. I would also like the opportunity to discuss your suggested study of a long acting fenfluramine.
