Dear Bill,

We have recently completed our pilot EEG study of AHR-1118, including experiments with single doses up to 350 mg, equivalent to 4.5 - 5.0 mg/kg. We have summarized this data and I am enclosing a copy for your information and files.

In these experiments, we have had difficulty in eliciting a consistent EEG pattern. At these higher dosages, however, some changes are prominent and to confirm these, I have undertaken a direct comparison, on a random assignment double-blind basis of single doses of AHR 1118 vs. placebo. The dosage selected is based on body weight, so that we will average 4.0 - 4.3 mg/kg. The variation is based on the 50 mg size capsule available.

This study will be completed in early June at present rate of examinations.
