Dr. R. Goesswald of FBA Medical Research in New York was kind enough to send us your curriculum vitae, with a recommendation that we consider your joining our staff to participate in our research programs. My associate, Dr. Turan Itil, formerly of the Department of Psychiatry in the University of Erlangen, and I have discussed your record and find it of considerable interest. Your experience appears to be primarily a clinical one and at the present time we are not anticipating any openings in this section of the Institute.

However, our animal laboratories will be completed late in April, and these facilities will be available for a wide variety of studies. We are anxious to undertake a series of EEG investigations in animals, to compare the changes observed in that setting with the changes in our patient population. For this reason, we are setting aside some funds for the appointment of a scientist to develop this study program. From your curriculum vitae, I am not aware of any direct experience in animal physiology, but if such an opportunity does interest you, I should be glad to receive your suggestions in this regard.

I have already thanked Dr. Goesswald for his consideration in recommending you to us.
