Dear Max: + Don

In April I sent you a summary of the EEG frequency analyses of the schizophrenic and depressive sub-groups. This problem interests me very much and Dr. Itil and I discussed it again this week. He reminded me that we really do not have an adequate psychopathological description of each of our patients. To the extent that it may be available, I would be grateful if you could make available the following information regarding the forty patients in this sub=study.

Have any been re-hospitalized? Both for these and for any other that you may have seen, what is your present diagnosis (if not made by you or Don, I would like to know who made it)? Is there any change in their prominent psychopathological picture to make you consider a change in classification?

Please tell Don that the galley proofs on the depression papers have come in and I have made all corrections indicated in his letter of September 23rd, except adding the p values, Table I. Since the samples are small, I would rather the narrative support the visual. You both should know that Dr. Bradley promised all the C. I. N. P. members on September 1st that the 1962 volume would be out by October 1st. I haven't seen it yet nor have I seen an announcement of it, but I have faith that it will see the light of day soon.
