Dear Miss Sewell:

I am most pleased that we will be able to cooperate with the National Library of Medicine and concomitantly determine the accuracy of our hand search for information. The terms from the Medical Subject Headings of the Index Medicus which we have requested are attached, and fall into three lists. From our point of view, the articles which should be included are those which relate to electroencephalography, in human subjects, and with the concurrent use or the effects of drugs having or presumed to have psychotropic action. For this reason, I would suggest that the search be for articles which satisfy three criteria concurrently, i.e., EEG and subjects and drugs.

Upon receipt of your list we will check it against ours and be glad to discuss any discrepancies.
