Dear Dr. McGrath:

Thank you very much for the supply of the 10 mg. capsules of librium and the placebo. We have compared these to a supply of Mellaril provided us by Sandoz, and I am pleased to say that they are indistinguishable.

We have recently reviewed our protocol and have set the dosage range for each capsul of librium as 10 mg. For the full year's study, we estimate that we will need 16,000 capsules of librium, 10 mgs. each, and a like amount of placebo. We have asked Sandoz to provide us with 8,000 capsules of placebo, and would request that you supply us with a like amount.

In the event that this can be accomplished, we are prepared to undertake this study beginning early in August.

Dr. Itil is looking forward to your visit at the end of July, and I regret that I will not be present. I am sure that my associates will provide you with a clear picture of our program. Your comments will be most appreciated.
