Separately I am sending you the summaries of the active and inactive cases of the cyclazocine trials from 8-1-66 to 3-31-67 at Metropolitan Hospital. There is little additional information available. I hope that these are useful.

I have arranged that these were summarized from the records by two resident physicians and agreed to compensate them at \$5.00 an hour. The review took 60 hours.

It would be most helpful if we could compensate these men indirectly and for this reason I would ask that Sterling-Winthrop make available a sum of \$300.00, to Psychopharmacology Services, Inc. and sent to me at the New York Medical College. This consulting firm will in turn compensate the residents.
