I would rate the two abstracts submitted in the latter group of acceptable presentations. If there will be a group of papers presented in EEG, then Dr. Andermann's report would be appropriate. Considering the importance of this subject, it may be an interesting report to hear.

The presentation by Frieske, Fowler and Wilson seems to be a circuitous way to demonstrate findings that have been demonstrated by others in animals before, and extensively documented in man. The absence of a theoretical or a novel observational framework makes me recommend this in the lower portion of the acceptable presentations.
