Dear Miss Berland:

In the two weeks since your visit here, I have explored a number of possibilities concerning your appointment. Dr. Garfield indicated that he would not be available for much of the summer period, and regretted that he would not be in a position to supervise a student this summer.

I made a similar inquiry to other members of the staff of the hospital, and found that no provision has as yet been made for summer employment. In large measure, this results from the stringency in funds which has generally restricted the State to appointments on a more permanent basis only. It is my impression, however, that if you wish to participate in the psychological program of the hospital on a volunteer basis, that this could be arranged.

I regret that I am unable to make a position available to you such as you have requested.
