I have read the various mock-ups of scales sent on June 12. To the extent it is possible to review these outside the laboratory situation, I have done so.

The RPR seems satisfactory.

The PMS is an interesting addition. It is not clear <sup>why</sup> ~~when~~ item II is requested. These items may be significant only in relation to concurrent illnesses or conditions, and I do not see this information recorded. But I see no difficulty in obtaining these data.

The DOTES is an interesting change, and one that seems easy to use.

TESS, Data Shipment, and DSE are difficult to assess but seem satisfactory.

We should have little difficulty in using these forms, and anticipate their implementation.
