Dear Alice, Martin and Andy,

Jonathan, Martha and I are delighted that Andy may be able to accompany us on our trip. As you can tell from the enclosed letter, I have requested the necessary transportation and accommodations for those portions of our forthcoming trip which are almost "fixed." As soon as I have the necessary visa application forms, I will send these on to you.

The portion of the trip from Istanbul, Athens, and Rome is left open because I am not sure as to the number of days that we will spend in Istanbul. As you know, this is a "business" portion for me as I am anxious to establish a collaborative study program with the University. I anticipate that Turan will be in Istanbul at that time, and while we may be busy professionally, I am confident that his friends will chaperon Martha and the boys.

I believe you should check and arrange for Andy's passport and make sure that he has the necessary vaccination for small-pox checked within the past two and one-half years so that it will be valid at the end of August when we expect to return to this country.

For the Russian visa he will need three photographs. It has been suggested that we have additional photographs available in case we require stopovers at other Eastern countries and for any special needs in the Soviet Union. I am planning to take four additional photographs and perhaps you should make eight copies at this time.

There is one additional change which is possible. Dr. Freedman has been in contact with Professor Jus in Warsaw and asked me on Monday whether I would be willing to meet with Professor Jus in order to establish a study program with his University as well. I expect that Professor Jus will be in Washington next month. If so, then the trip to Warsaw may not be necessary. If not, we may take a two day trip to Warsaw in that portion Moscow - Istanbul.
