Thank you very much for your willingness to see my associate Dr. Donald Sundland, who will visit with you on Wednesday morning, December 9th. He is particularly interested in problems of reaction time phenomena in schizophrenic subjects. When Sol Garfield was here they launched a program of study on the differences between "process" and "reaction" schizophrenia.

In the last few months I have suggested that we might derive more information from concurrent EEG and reaction time studies. We have become interested then in the problem of continuous performance measures.

Knowing your interest and experience in such experimental approaches to classifications of sub-groups to schizophrenia, I would be pleased if Don could get to meet Sam Sutton and any other members of your staff interested in this type of experimental physiology.

Don's other interest is in the development of typological approaches to the classification of psychotics. He is well acquainted with your very early studies on cluster analysis.
