Gentlemen:

At various times during the year, in conjunction with NIMH grants 18172 and contract 42-70-98, I have imported to the laboratories in New York, various components of cannabis and various synthetic opiates and antagonists. In the past, I have obtained the appropriate import permits, as these were needed.

Similarly, on occasion, our co-workers in Europe, request samples of these substances for research purposes, and we have requested export licenses.

I am writing at the suggestion of Mr. Steven Stacy, to obtain the necessary registration forms to register as both an importer and an exporter of proscribed substances under the various limiting schedules.

I already hold, on behalf of my laboratory, the various BNDD certificates for studies of scheduled substances.
