Dear Mr. Hamilton:

As we discussed some weeks ago, we are now establishing an early clinical drug evaluation unit at this institution. While it was my expectation that we would consider In-379 first, Dr. Gershon has expressed particular interest in the other compound which you described to us, IN-1060. Because of the similarity in its pharmacological action to other compounds of particular interest to us, we would like to request a supply of this compound, approximately 3 grams, preferably in solution, for trial in our animals. Indeed, if you are willing to expand this study, we should be interested in some of the analogs of this compound as well, which were described in the brochure.

Following our animal studies, if IN-1060 demonstrates the activity we anticipate, we would be interested in undertaking a clinical drug evaluation.
