Dear Stanley:

Separately I am sending you two boxes of the tapes prepared by Dr. Don in the LSD study which was undertaken during the summer months. There are nineteen records in the collection, including the one which he had sent to you earlier. The attached sheet gives the date of recording, name, and dosage of drug in each record. The dosage of LSD is calculated on a 1 mg/kg basis. The largest number of samples are in Larry Payne in which multiple doses were given. The 40 mcg dose represents the equivalent of 1 mg/kg.

In five subjects, a Saline administration was done as a control. The tape which you have is that of Miss Armstrong and the Saline is included in this group as her control.

The time of examination varied from 40 minutes to one hour after the administration of LSD.

We are now analyzing the EEG samples and as soon as these are completed, will send you a complete record of the pupillary changes wherever available and the EEG scores for the measurement of differences from pre-drug to just before the post-drug interview.

I will call you during one of my next visits to New York to discuss this analysis. My best regards.
