Dear Dr. Meyer:

Following the receipt last week of a Federal permit for marijuana study, we prepared the enclosed protocol for study of marijuana and tetrahydrocannabinols. This protocol has been approved by the Chairman, Dr. Alfred M. Freedman and will be submitted to the appropriate committees of the College.

While MH-13358 (EEG and Human Psychopharmacology) provides funds for the EEG aspects of this study, additional funds are necessary and a proposed budget in the amount of \$43,360 for direct costs is enclosed. An appropriate indirect cost rate will be determined administratively. We are prepared to submit such additional data as may be required to undertake the study as a contract.

It is our understanding that supplies of marijuana, THC- Δ -1 and possibly THC- Δ -6 will be made available by your office. The laboratory and clinical facilities are equipped to undertake this study immediately and we would request support effective July 1, 1968.
