Dear Stan,

It has been some time since we communicated. I trust all is well in Baltimore.

Our week has fallen into a routine. I had a research fellow from Italy with me this past year, and he has left. He stimulated our interest in anticonvulsants and we are now studying these actively.

We have completed some blood level/EEG studies and demonstrated the very high correlations for the drugs we studied. We think EEG can be used where blood measures are hard to come by.

The Greek volume is about 60% done and should be out next year. I am ~~writing~~ writing another on EST.

We are developing some ties to Hillside Hospital. Enclosed is a paper sent me by one of their staff who is interested in joining SUNY. I cannot evaluate the merits of the thoughts or processes. Can you give me an informal opinion of this work?
