Enclosed are the latest group of reports on cyclazocine, representing patients #0100 to 0114. You will note that most of the subjects of this group received an induction period which was much shorter than previously and as a consequence suffered insomnia, floating feelings, nervousness and irritability. In most instances we have given the patients oral naloxone first as soon as symptoms occurred and more recently on patient demand.
