Dear van Lierop,

I have had the opportunity to check one of the coded tapes using the decoder. We at first had much difficulty but were able, by carefully adjusting gains, to achieve the samples enclosed. The decoder is very sensitive and we have to adjust the gains on the tape recorder very carefully.

Please check the enclosed samples, and if they reflect the code on the tape, it would be helpful if you would advise us how to read this code, for our record purposes in indicating the samples which we may have to reject; and in noting the onset and end of different records.

We have received the samples of GB-94 and are in the process of establishing our own dosage schedule for amitriptyline before examining the GB-94.
