Dear Dr. Kielholz:

I have received various letters from the CINP Program Chairman, Dr. Vinar, and my answer to the latest is enclosed.

1. The symposium that has been submitted consists of the titles listed.

2. The co-symposium is to be made up of submitted "free communications". My letter to Dr. Vinar suggests we could have all 12 (abstracts enclosed) but would prefer 1-8, suggesting 9-12 to be presented in the "Free Communications". The decision is to be left to Dr. Vinar.

3. He asks that one of us summarize the proceedings in the Plenary session. Since I am presenting in the symposium, would it not be appropriate for you to summarize the sessions? I would be delighted to have you do so.

4. The papers of the symposium and co-symposium may make a find issue of a journal, and I would ask if you would consider this for your journal, Pharmakopsychiatrie? (Incidentally, your letter of February 9 was not clear whether you did indeed wish a report on antagonists and methadone for a subsequent issue of Pharmakopsychiatrie.)

I look forward to our working together in Prague.
