Thank you very much for your letter of June 11, and Dr. Delay's article. I have had it photocopied and am returning the original to you for your files. We have already approved a study of dibenzothiazepine, following the recommendation of Dr. Don after the ECDEU Meeting and Dr. Itil, based on some data he has from Europe. However, the Dorsey Laboratories, who represent Wander in the United States, indicated that this compound is not yet available for study. As soon as it is, we would be pleased to undertake a trial.

In the meantime, we are planning a trial with cycloserine and I am writing to Ivan Bennett today for supplies. Thank you for your help.
