Dear Rudy:

Enclosed is a copy of the abstract submitted by George Ulett to the CINP. The data for this study is that material collected by him two years ago and presented, in part, at various meetings since. It is our intention to summarize both his experiences, those of Dr. Itil, and my own with regard to the EEG effects of combined drugs.

With regard to the method of administration of these compounds, I do not believe we intended to mix the compounds. It is our policy to give medication to patients in liquid vehicle, and they are accustomed to receiving one or two liquids two to three times a day. Since we will be giving two known compounds and administering them separately, I do not believe that an IND would be necessary. I hope this is a feasible resolution.
