A formal summary of our experience with Mr. DOMINICK CHINDAMO is enclosed.

At the time of his discharge from the hospital, we were not assured that the relief that ECT had afforded him would persist, and encouraged him to continue on tricyclic antidepressant medication. His daughter called me a few weeks after his discharge, relating that he had some recurrence of symptoms. I encouraged continuation of medication, but failing that, offered to see him again for further ECT at University Hospital if his physicians thought it would be useful.
