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Dear Joe,

It was kind of you to write and to send your latest reprint. I have just cited your work in a summary of the Dahlem Conference on pattern recognition, in which we were interested in different methods to describe the changes induced in behavior by various stresses or agents.

Enclosed are some examples of our recent EEG studies. For the most part, these reflect the two themes of our EEG work, the characterization of new drug profiles and the determination of the pharmacodynamic activity of psychoactive drugs. The DPH paper is particularly illuminating, indicating that even when some authors fail to find a profile for a psychoactive drug, determination and cognizance of the pharmacokinetics will win out.

I did complete a book on ECT earlier this year, and it has been well received.
