Congratulations on your new assignment. The answer to your question is difficult since I have no appreciation of the space available, nor the types of programs you envision. For example, if the lab is primarily clinical, then a Grass EEG is possibly best; but, if research, then a more sensitive amplifier system (Offner) may be recommended.

May I suggest you visit McGill and ask the advice of the EEG chief there (whoever replaced Shagass) - or call Dr. Sarwer-Foner at Queen Mary's and ask his advice.
