Dear Dean:

Enclosed are a few final copies of the report presented before the Society of Biological Psychiatry, and the carbon of a letter which I have just sent to Chuck Hall in response to inquiries which I have received from him. I do not know how to evaluate his desire to review the Hillside data. The analyses that he accomplished with you are good, and I wonder if we cannot gain more from giving him the data and letting him work with it in his own compulsive manner, than by withholding it? While this is probably a decision for my associates at Hillside to make with me, I would be grateful for your recommendation.

I hope you get the additional equipment you requested, and that you establish an EEG analysis facility. As part of the Collaborative Schizophrenia Project I have decided to co-operate with Hy Denber in analyzing tapes that he is going to collect for us in New York. I anticipate some problems in making the tapes compatible, but I believe this experience will be useful for all of us.
