Thank you for the opportunity to discuss our problems with you. Since my return I have inquired as to the availability of a twin-track recorder with half-track heads. Such instruments are available, but they are much to expensive for us at present, being quoted at approximately \$1,000.

I would appreciate your listening to the first part of the tape and sending a critique back to me. As we listened to it, it seems quite clear and the two tracks are loud and separate.
