Dear Dr. Cahan:

Please excuse my delay in answering your letter, but in the interim I have changed my location to the new Missouri Institute of Psychiatry. In my studies at the Hillside Hospital we did not have any system of coding our EEG records for IBM. Most of our work was in frequency analysis and all the data for twenty-four frequencies were transcribed from the special write-outs of the instrument to data sheets. Analyses have been done on the individual frequencies and we have made no effort to classify our basic records in any other way.

I am enclosing a reprint of one of our latest reports, as this may give you an idea about our method of handling our data. If you desire any more information, I should be glad to answer any specific questions.
