The enclosed galley proof is correct, and I thank you for the second proof.

I note that you have changed the word "doxepin" to "doxepine" in the title and the text. In the German summary, doxepin is spelled without the "e".

It is my impression that doxepin is a generic name which in the United States is sold under the trade name Sinequan. My use of the word "doxepin-type" was an attempt to provide reference to the generic name. I would ask that you review this report and make such changes in the spelling as may be consistent with your editorial policy.
