Dear Dr. Flegel:

I was pleased to receive your most recent letter, and have had the opportunity to review your curriculum vitae with my associate, Dr. Turan Itil.

I am taking the opportunity to write to Dr. Borger as you suggested. To complete this application, it would be helpful for me to be able to write to one of your present associates in Germany, Professor Panse or another of your co-workers whom you may designate.

In general, salaries for research fellows holding the M.D. degree are in the range of \$7,200 to \$10,000 per year.

The Institute has no accommodations of its own, but has been able on occasion to make available apartments at the St. Louis State Hospital for visiting scientists for a temporary period. This usually permits us to find accommodations in the neighborhood of the Institute, and we have been successful with all of our staff to date.

Since writing you last, I have completed the first annual report of the Institute, and I am enclosing a copy.
