Dear Turan,

Some time ago, Hy Denber brought to my attention the problem of magnetic tapes which he had shipped to St. Louis, and which had not been returned to him. On one of my visits I went through the Computer Center with Connie and we found a number of tapes which were then shipped to Dr. Denber.

I thought we had shipped all except the few which I had set aside from the cyclazocine project. During my last visit, I checked again and all those that we could find were sent to my office, except two tapes which I had intended to carry with me and which I requested Connie to mail.

Enclosed is a memorandum from Dr. Denber and he indicates that 44 tapes are still missing. There are four in my office and two which are en route from St. Louis to New York. This still leaves an accounting for 38 tapes.

Would you personally institute a search and advise me as to the best solution to this question?
