I would like to participate in the Western EEG meetings in March, and my application form is enclosed.

In San Diego, I mentioned the rump session of the EEG/Psychiatrists that I intended to run in New York. The meeting was held and it was quite successful. More than 30 people showed up, and we had a good discussion of the merits of EEG in psychiatry. The limitations were also discussed, and while these seemed more formidable than the applications, there was consensus that the present study programs, particularly in relating EEG changes to specific aspects of behavior, were going very well. When I have the chance I will summarize the meeting and send you a copy. There may yet be formal meetings of those interested in man's behavioral changes and the EEG correlates.
