Dear Arnold,

Enclosed is a copy of the inventory of equipment of the International Association, as of April 1, 1973. Items 1000-1003 are at the office of the Association, 39 Arleigh Road; items 1004-1143 are at the State University of New York at Stony Brook; and items 1144-1175 are at the New York Medical College (5 East 102nd St.). The items at the State University of New York include the computer installation and most of the technical equipment.

While most of the items can be considered "self-insured", it would be prudent to obtain coverage against fire, water damage and vandalism for the IBM 1800 system (items 1022-1059).

I am also enclosing documents from the New York Medical College describing the transfer of the equipment to the Association; the relevant chapters of the HEW grants administration manual (chapter 1-410); the grant award for MH 24020 which includes \$16,500 for renovation of space for this equipment; and an abstract from NIH DRG Newsletter (volume 10, number 2) dated February, 1973, which answers some questions regarding the transfer of equipment. These documents have been reviewed by Mr. Joshua Vogel, our legal advisor, and it was his opinion that legal title has been transferred to the Association, and that we should do all things which would be prudent for the maintenance and protection of the equipment.
