Dear Mme. Verdeaux:

Dr. Bradley and I are pleased to confirm the invitation for your participation in the symposium on Anticholinergic Hallucinogens at the forthcoming meeting of the CINP to be held in Washington, D.C. on March 29 and 31. We look forward to your discussion of the effects of cholinergic agents on behavior. As there are still a few questions about the ability of some of the European invitees to attend the meeting, it will be a few weeks before we can send a definitive program and time schedule.

Dr. Bradley and I have recommended to the CINP committee some financial support for your visit. They have indicated that the distribution of funds may lie with Dr. Deniker and we would suggest that you write to him.

Five reports will be presented during each three hour session, allowing thirty-five minutes for each presentation and discussion. Since the discussion may be of special interest to the participants, the report should be about 20 minutes in length.

Since we would like to print a program including abstracts for distribution at the meeting, would you favor me by a title, list of co-authors, and a paragraph or two describing your presentation?

The CINP has permitted us to consider the publication of this symposium separately. Insofar as this subject is becoming increasingly important, we believe that the association of the work of the participants in a single volume will be a valuable contribution, and ask your cooperation in making a manuscript available at the time of the meeting. The manuscript should be approximately 20 pages of text, plus bibliography and illustrations.

We look forward to your participation.
