Dear Dr. Simeon:

In order to expedite the application for preferential visa, it will be necessary for you to submit photostatic copies of your diploma, D.P.M. certificate and E.C.F.M.G. certificate. The copies that I have are not certified and can not be used. It will be advisable for you to prepare copies and take them to the American ~~Consull~~ in Edinburgh asking him to certify that they are true copies.

In addition, it will be necessary to submit an English translation of your diploma and this, too, should be certified by the ~~Consull~~.

As soon as I have received these documents, I will be able to prepare the necessary immigration application.

With regard to the date of your joining our staff, the immigration authorities tell me that a minimum period for the clearance of such an application is 6-8 weeks. It seems to me that you could plan to join the Institute early in March and if this is satisfactory with you I will make the arrangements here. I'm looking forward to having you join our staff.
